Doggie Day Camp Liability Release

Doggie Day Camp has been created at Acacia Animal Health Center, "AAHC", because we know dogs are social animals and enjoy the companionship of playing with other dogs. In fact, when left to their own resources, dogs will actually form social packs as part of their natural activities. When dogs are routinely left at home for 8 to 10 hours a day, they can become bored and therefore sometimes quite destructive and even depressed.

By participating in our camp, your dog can make new friends and enjoy a full day of play! When they return home, they are usually looking forward to rest and relaxation just like you after a long day! During *Doggie Day Camp*, your dog(s) can play with other dogs while being supervised by a camp counselor. The mental and physical benefits for your beloved dog will be significant.

Some dogs, specifically those with undesirable behavior problems, will not be allowed to participate.

Dog(s) wishing to join AAHC's *Doggie Day Camp* will have to ask their owners to read, understand and fulfill the following conditions:

1. Dog owners may request that their dog(s) participates by signing this form.
2. Prior to the first day in camp, a camp counselor will evaluate your dog(s) to determine if they meet our behavioral guidelines for participation. For obvious safety reasons, all campers must be friendly with other dogs.
3. Campers must be spayed or neutered, and be current on vaccines.
4. Campers must be flea-free. If found, a fast-acting flea killing treatment will be administered at a nominal charge.
5. As the owner, you agree that AAHC cannot be held liable for injuries to your dog that may occur during normal camp activities. This includes things such as scratches, wounds/punctures, eye and leg injuries. In addition, damage to Acacia's personal property will also be the responsibility of the dog owner.
6. By signing this form, you authorize AAHC to take whatever reasonable measures they deem medically necessary for the health and well being of your dog(s). Further, you agree to pay for veterinary care that is determined to be necessary by our veterinarian.
7. In the event of an emergency, you will be contacted immediately. As the dog's owner, you must assume responsibility for making sure your emergency contact numbers are current.

This waiver and release agreement specifically includes each and every event and activity provided by AAHC and its *Doggie Day Camp*. The conditions set forth in this form will remain in effect as long as your dog(s) attends our camp or until such time another signed camp waiver/release form is executed.

AAHC cannot guarantee that its activities for dogs will be safe, effective or suitable for all dogs. For this reason, all such services, activities and programs are offered without warranties or guarantees of any kind, express or implied and AAHC disclaims any liability, loss or damages that may result from your dog's participation.
